I-25/University Avenue Interchange

After several years of studies, public input, and engineering design, a contractor has been selected to rebuild the University Avenue and I-25 interchange. An equipment staging area has been prepared and is currently in use in anticipation of the January 2, 2020 construction start date (two-year construction duration). The project will include the following improvements:

- New University Avenue Bridge over I-25 to accommodate growth
- Triviz underpass of University Avenue
- Continuation of Triviz multi-use path to connect to NMSU bike lanes
- New exit ramp from southbound I-25 directly to NMSU beneath University Avenue
- Roundabouts merging traffic on both sides of University/Triviz underpass
- New entrance ramp from NMSU to I-25 southbound
- Roadway improvements to University Avenue from Triviz to Las Alturas to accommodate pedestrians and bicycles.

Electric Scooters

- Spring 2019: NMSU trial electric scooter program to determine the feasibility of permanently implementing.
- RFP issued early 2019 to bring scooters to campus via a qualified vendor(s); an RFP evaluation committee was formed, proposals ranked, and a vendor identified as the most qualified to implement a safe and effective scooter transportation program to our campus.
- A vendor recommendation was made to NMSU President Floros on August 30, and an E-Scooter Safety Study is currently being conducted.
