General Information

- 60 day trial started on January 18, 2019
 - 100 Scooters
 - Dropped off at 7am and picked up 7pm to charge (Corbett, Resident Halls & Horseshoe
 - Use Spin App to rent at \$1 per ride, \$0.15 per minute
- Not NMSU property. Owned by Spin Scooters (subsidiary of Ford Motor).



General Information

- Scooters are considered vehicle by state statute at this time.
- Riders should be aware of traffic laws and safety regulations.
- Call NMSU PD if there is an issue with scooters such as collision or parking of the scooter.



Safety Tips

- Considered a vehicle by state law, follow all traffic laws.
- Must stop at all stop signs and red lights.
- Keep in control.
- Responsible for avoiding collision.
- Be defensive, look out.
- Wear a helmet.
- Stop, look and listen before crossing street.
- No tricks, point A to Point B only.
- Park out of the way of others.
- Look out for grates.
- Ride with flow of traffic.



Safety Tips

- Must yield to pedestrians, slow down.
- Operate within bike lanes, on streets or designated sidewalks.
- Must dismount in heavy pedestrian area.
- Not allowed inside buildings, fire hazard.
- Only operate on paved surface.
- Operator should have headlight or reflectors on person if in low light conditions.
